#### A Note from our Executive Director

Winter arrived a bit early. We do have 6-month snow clearing service that begins officially on November 1<sup>st</sup>, but as you can tell we had to use the service early. For your information, our snow clearing expenses are almost \$3,000 per month, and is split equally between the Hellenic Community, the mall and ourselves. Between the parking lot and pathways we have a lot of space to maintain and we do our best to keep our facility as safe as possible.

To update our situation with the mandated installation of a grease trap or Fats, Oil & Grease (FOG) Interceptor, we were hoping we would be able to install under the cabinet grease traps instead of digging up the kitchen floor to install a FOG interceptor. It appears we will need to install one or two FOG Interceptors underneath the hallway between the kitchen and washrooms. This project will necessitate the closing of our building for a few days. The timeframe has yet to be determined but we think it will be early in the new year. We are hopeful to minimize the interruption to as little as possible but there will be programming and events that will be postponed or cancelled by the installation. This will be an expensive installation. We feel confident that the City will pay for 75% of the costs and the rest will be our responsibility.

Thank you to our donors, funders and sponsors who support us throughout the year and who have helped us navigate all the unexpected and unbudgeted building maintenance surprises. We will need additional fundraising and donation support for this expense that could possibly be as much as \$10,000 to us.

Thank you to all our volunteers who have helped with several great programs and events throughout the fall. You are what makes Bow Cliff special!

Our Super Membership family continues to grow, and we expect to make a major announcement on new organizations joining before the year end. Thank you to all the Super Members who have joined us for our events and to the Super Member Partners who have welcomed our members to their programs and events.

We continue to experience an increased level of colds, flu and COVID amongst our membership. We encourage everyone to stay home if you're not feeling well. Stay warm and stay healthy!
